## Township Updates and Election News

- This year, our area saw major changes with the new town hall project. Many residents protested the build, expressing frustration when the township barred public attendance at the ceremony. Construction began in November and is progressing quickly.
- We encourage everyone to stay informed and take part in the upcoming election in 2026.

## Community Updates

- **Beach Access Enhancements:** This past summer, after numerous meetings with township officials, the Township completed much-needed repairs to the main beach pathway, added a platform and installed new signage to improve safety and accessibility for all residents and guests.
- **Dune Preservation:** Members of our committee continue to monitor the health of our sensitive dune ecosystem. Ingrid and board members removed most of invasive species such as phragmites that thrive in wetlands competing against plants native to the area.
- With the support of the Township and the Severn Sound Environmental Association (SSEA) the board with help from Ken, Nick, Ingrid and Ania were able to populate the dunes with 12 white pine trees and 30 milkweed plants (at no cost). Members of the board also watered and placed mulch around the trees. The SSEA have deemed the existing scotch pines as invasive and has recommended to the Township that they be removed in the future.
